SPECIAL SESSION – June 25, 2024

A Special Session of the Carver County Board of Commissioners was held in the County Government Center, Chaska, on June 25, 2024. Chair Gayle Degler convened the session at 9:02 a.m.

Members present: Gayle Degler, Chair, John P. Fahey, Vice Chair, Matt Udermann and Tom Workman.

Members absent: Tim Lynch

Udermann moved, Workman seconded, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

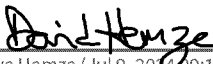
Deb Paige, Emergency Management spoke about declaring a local emergency for Carver County due to spring flooding. Paige advised that declaring a local emergency opens up eligibility for state and federal funding. Currently the threshold for FEMA funding is \$491,841 and state funding is \$245,920 in damages. This resolution will effectively extend the state of emergency declaration signed by Commissioner Chair Degler on June 21, 2024.

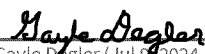
