The Sheriff has identified opportunities to leverage technology to further accountability, transparency, public safety, and recruitment/retention efforts in the Sheriff's Office. Areas of technology include but are not limited to transitioning of the in car camera system, expansion of the body worn camera program within the the jail facility, and VR simulation technology to further scenario based training for the Sheriff's Office team. Utilization of \$525,000 of Public Safety Aid recieved from the State of Mn offers an opportunity to further technology initiatives without current or budget year levy impact.
